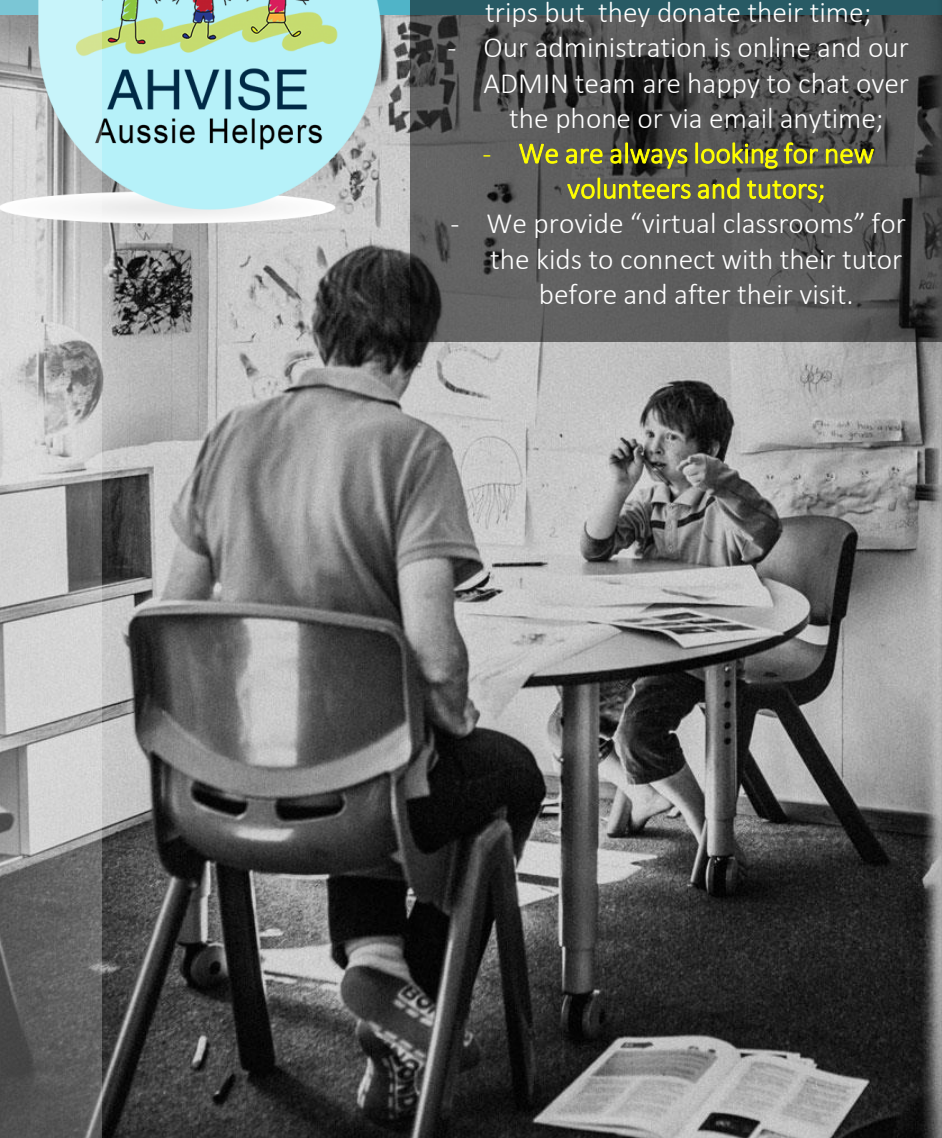




How we run AHVISE so efficiently:
